

Dr. Hoon Lee's research interests span leisure tourism theory, festival event management, sustainable tourism management, and local tourism content development, contributing significantly to the advancement of the field.

Professor Kim's research focuses on tourism experiences, accommodation and online platform policies, and festival planning and content development. He employs both quantitative and qualitative research methods to explore the intricacies of these areas.

His contributions to the field include publications such as "Touristic Quest for Existential Authenticity" in the Annals of Tourism Research, "Assessing the economic values of World Heritage Sites and the effects of perceived authenticity on their values" in the International Journal of Tourism Research, and "Understanding Participation Patterns and Trends in Tourism Cultural Attractions" in Tourism Management.

"Trends & Lessons in Tourism Product Development: The case in South Korea"

Abstract:

The tourism industry faced a brief crisis due to the pandemic but is rapidly recovering to prepandemic levels starting in 2023. Tourism is a very important industry in Korea and is also recognized as an efficient means to respond to the problem of regional extinction. In this presentation, three tourism projects that were successfully carried out in Korea were introduced. The first example is the free admission policy for Hanbok wearers that has been implemented since 2013 at Gyeongbokgung Palace, Korea's representative cultural heritage tourism destination. Through this policy, the Hanbok experience spread nationwide and a new industry related to Hanbok rental emerged. Tourists in Hanbok are meaningful in that they play the role of prosumer who creates experiences for other tourists. The second example is Gamcheon Culture Village in Busan. This case shows that the Village Art Project, a public art policy, is acting not only as a means of urban regeneration but also as a catalyst for village tourism. The third example is the Hwacheon Sancheoneo Festival, which is mentioned as one of the world's best winter festivals. This case shows a strategy to transform the region's unfavorable natural environment into a tourism product through new content called ice fishing. These three cases suggest that direct participation of tourists, cooperation of various stakeholders, and return of economic profits to the community are the key factors for the successful development of tourism.

His ultimate goal is to create a non-invasive concussion assessment tool that can be utilized in both sporting and military contexts. Additionally, he explores movement quantification to detect early signs of dysfunction in movement and pain caused by diseases such as osteoarthritis, autism, and Alzheimer's.

In addition to his role at Pusan National University, Dr. O'Sullivan contributes to the field through his responsibilities on the Para-Taekwondo Research and Educational Board of the World Taekwondo Federation (WT). He actively engages in international collaboration and research, particularly in the development and regulation of international Paralympic sports.

"Digital Sports Healthcare: A Vital Approach to Addressing Aging Challenges in Korea"

The once-accepted muscle loss in aging is now recognized as sarcopenia, designated a disease code by the U.S. CDC in 2016. With low compliance to physical activity guidelines among the elderly, a paradigm shift is needed towards personalized exercise programs embedded in daily digital sports healthcare. Establishing a comprehensive digital sports total healthcare platform, continuously upgrading through data analysis, and linking with the local medical system can provide a crucial social safety net. This transition is essential for a healthy and happy future in Korea's imminent superaging society.

"Trends in Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging and Key Technology Developments"

Abstract:

In the past two decades, electric vehicles (EVs) have emerged as a viable alternative to internal combustion engine vehicles to reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Despite being environment friendly, limited driving range and long battery charging time are two major obstacles to increase customer acceptance for EV. Mrs. Gurung has demonstrated leadership in the Non-Resident Nepali Association National Coordination Council (NRNA NCC) Australia, serving from 2013 to 2015. Her involvement extends to disaster relief, workshops supporting women's causes, and empowerment initiatives. Alongside her husband, she achieved the historic distinction of being the first billionaire in the global Nepalese diaspora and the only second billionaire of Nepalese origin worldwide. "Sustainable Sports Tourism"

Abstract:

Sustainable Sports Tourism (SST) is an emerging sector of the global travel industry that has a substantial economic impact such as generating billions of dollars in revenue and providing a boost to local businesses and communities. It should contribute to the local economy, promote ecological responsibility, and preserve the environment and cultural heritage. Sustainable sports can be linked to the green movement from constructing sports infrastructures to exploring, developing, and utilizing renewable energy sources. Such initiatives help reduce carbon emissions and promote renewable energy adoption. Thus, it has the potential to counter the negative impacts of climate change.

Attracting Investment, preserving resources, and benefiting local communities are some of the advantages of sustainable sports tourism. The global sports tourism market was valued at USD 587.87 billion in 2022 and is expected to expand at a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 17.5% from 2023 to 2030.

Balancing economic development with environmental and social sustainability, and making understandable the relation of sustainable sports with tourism and climate change to those not very aware of sustainability are some of the challenges of SST. Price fixing, among others, may be another challenge of the global tourism market especially for those on tight budgets.


